


THE KNOWLEDGE MIGHT BE HELPFUL, IF I WERE TO SOMEDAY RUN MY OWN BUSINESS.

STARTED DIVING INTO A FEW MAJOR PROJECTS.



ORDERED CATERING AND BOUGHT FOOD FROM SK




DESIGNED A GRADUATION COOKBOOK FOR THE TRAINEES OF THE

NEW HAVEN




THIS SUMMER WAS ALSO MY



MOMENTS OF CURIOSITY, LAUGHTER, AND CONNECTION.


